Professor Torbjörn von Schantz

Vice-Chancellor Lund University

Torbjörn is a Professor of zoology with a long background in evolutionary and molecular ecology. He has previously served as Deputy Vice-Chancellor at the Swedish University of Agricultural Sciences (SLU) and as the Dean of the Faculty of Science at Lund University.



Professor Kerstin Tham

Vice-Chancellor, Malmö University

Kerstin is a Professor in Occupational therapy. Her research is focusing on activities and participation in everyday life after stroke from a rehabilitation perspective. She has extensive experience in university collaboration in Africa.



Professor Mats Viberg

Vice-Chancellor, Blekinge Institute of Technology

Mats is Vice-Chancellor of BTH since 1 September 2018. Before that, he was employed by Chalmers University of Technology for 25 years as a Professor of Signal Processing. His research area is statistical signal processing, especially multi-sensor data.

Vice-Chancellor, Kristianstad University

Håkan is an Associate Professor of business administration and has conducted research in international business and environmental economics. His recent focus is especially on the climate issue.
