


























Our aim, objectives and remit

- Academic network since 2009 unique in Sweden

- Main objective: Promote common issues in regional, national and international contexts where the universities can make a difference and promote even better and stronger regions.
- Universitities in South Sweden collaborate by:
 - · Providing synergies through the exchange of experiences, cooperation and greater collective planning
 - Enabling greater influence when approaching the Government, public authorities, regions, municipalities and funding bodies on common issues

- Facilitating mobility between the universities for students, teaching staff and researchers
- Promoting widening participation and recruitment to higher education together with civil society, municipalities and regions
- Helping to highlight the importance and concept of education and lifelong learning
- Influencing the long-term planning of housing, public transport and other infrastructure in close collaboration with regional and municipal stakeholders

- Pursuing the network's common interests in an international context through a representation in Brussels since 2018












